# NORTH & SOUTH PA

There's always something new to experience in these urban neighborhoods near Balboa Park, which are known by locals and tourists alike as the city's hipster havens



### **NORTH PARK**

You'll find the heart of the neighborhood in the myriad restaurants, bars and breweries within walking distance of 30th Street and University Avenue. Get an espresso at Caffè Calabria or a cup of trendy Japanese green tea at Holy Matcha, stop by West Coast Tavern or Waypoint Public for elevated pub fare and craft brews, or try the exotic alligator, elk or camel burgers at Crazee Burger. There's always a line at Carnitas' Snack Shack, but the pork sandwiches and bacon ketchup are worth the wait. Craft beer lovers shouldn't miss the tap selection at Toronado, or the tasting rooms at North Park Brewing Company, Belching Beaver or Rip Current Brewing. End the night at Bar Pink, U-31 or True North, and check out DAM Park, a new two-story event space with food vendors,

retailers and bars. Shoppers will appreciate Simply Local for one-of-a-kind souvenirs and Pigment for stylish home decor and hanging succulents.

## Street Fairs

On the second Saturday of every month, Ray Street in North Park hosts Ray at Night, an art walk with musicians, food trucks and vendors. The quarterly South Park Walkabout is a great way to sample foods from area restaurants and experience the character of the neighborhood.

#### SOUTH PARK

This residential nook of San Diego is big on small business. It's full of cozy cafés, pubs and boutiques. Get an authentic Neapolitan pizza at Buona Forchetta, pasta at Piacere Mio, inventive vegan dishes and cocktails at Kindred, and French pastries at Café Madeleine. Visit Hamiltons Tavern, a pioneer in serving craft beer, and its neighboring South Park Brewing Company. On and near Fern Street, you'll find a variety of shops: Make Good, which only sells handmade gifts by local artists; Graffiti Beach for fashion from emerging designers; and Mythology EcoBoutique for vegan leather and natural products. For vintage clothing and home decor, check out Bad Madge & Company, Brake & Rumble, Gold Leaf and Junc.Life Mercantile.
