WE'LL SEA: NEW VENUES RIGHT ALONG THE COAST (OR ALMOST)

A wave of fresh eateries is sweeping across the San Diego coastline, and the outlook is swell. From the Embarcadero to PB to Carlsbad, sea (pun intended) what's new and what's coming soon.

BREAKFAST REPUBLIC: OCEAN BEACH

The latest outlet of San Diego entrepreneur Johan Engman's fast-expanding breakfast empire opened in April in the former O.B. Warehouse space. Breakfast Republic occupies the large building's second floor. The bottom floor will soon become a Coin Haus, an old-fashioned arcade and pour-your-own beer hall by Cohn Restaurant Group.

PARK 101: CARLSBAD

This multilevel, 8,000-square-foot destination in Carlsbad Village – scheduled to open in June – will include a market, shops, a picnic-friendly plaza and four dining and drinking options. Owned and managed by Peter Cich, Doug Sondomowicz and Rob McShea, Park 101 will include both grab-and-go and sit-down options. The park's market will serve takeout hot sandwiches, juices and coffee, ice cream and house-made doughnuts. Park 101 Barbecue will serve ribs and other meat-centric barbecue dishes. The Garden Pub will offer up to 32 local beers on tap and regional wines. And the Tamarack View Deck will serve gourmet snacks from a rooftop lounge with seats arranged around fire pits.

UNNAMED PACIFIC BEACH PROJECT

Back in 2015, the venerable dive bar PB Bar & Grill was sold to the Verant Group, the hospitality collective that runs West Coast Tavern, True North, barleymash and Sandbar. The new owners closed it that spring, and it's been undergoing a heavy remodel ever since. The concept and its opening date have been kept under wraps, but Verant officials said it will be a restaurant/bar.

WATERBAR SAN DIEGO: PACIFIC BEACH

The long-shuttered Joe's Crab Shack on the boardwalk near Crystal Pier has been razed to make way for a large ocean-centric restaurant/bar with floor-to-ceiling windows and a menu focused on shellfish from the East and West coasts, as well as Baja. Owners are billing it as a "social seafood experience" that's part social club, part breakfast spot and part dinner house/bar. It's scheduled to open in August/September.
