Mavericks Beach Club is coming onshore early next year



Get ready Pacific Beach, a new all-day, all-encompassing entertainment complex called **Mavericks Beach Club** is headed your way. Replacing Pacific Beach Bar and Grill, which closed two years ago, Mavericks is bringing the party back to the neighborhood with a 15,000-square-foot two-level indoor/outdoor space that will span five full cocktail bars.

Scheduled to open February 2018 on Garnet Avenue, Mavericks is another joint venture between **David Cohen** and the <u>Verant Group's</u> **Eric Lingenfelder** and **Mark Cirillo**; other Verant locations include Sandbar Sports Grill, True North Tavern, The Smoking Gun, and Spill the Beans.

Serving Baja-inspired food at lunch and dinner, Mavericks Beach Club will be an all-in-one party destination, offering communal tables and cozy seats around a fireplace for dining and drinking as well as outdoor games, sports, a dance club and live entertainment; block parties with DJs and performance by national touring bands are planned. "We've created Mavericks to pay homage to California's largest surf break and one of the world's top surfing destinations. Mavericks captures and celebrates California's infectious beach and surf culture," said Lingenfelder.
